At minimum please identify the following for the reach you are studying:

- Show where the river is (watershed and geographically)
- Human impacts
- Identify the thalweg
- Identify bankfull
- Provide an estimate of the velocity
- Show any geomorphic units
- Estimate which zone (aggragation, degredation, etc.). Explain why.
- Alluvial vs non-alluvial. Explain why.
- Sediment size
